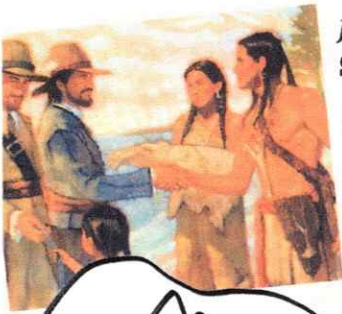

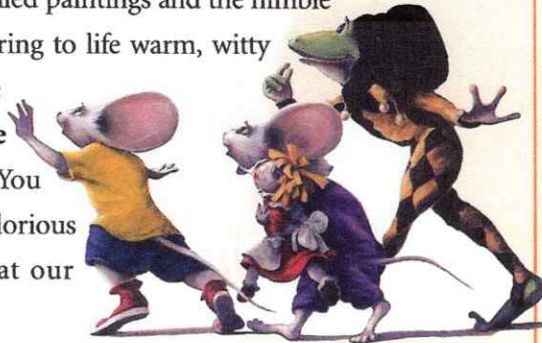
## DR. SEUSS & MR. SCHULZ

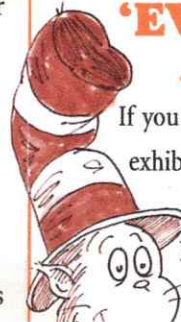
